Applying a Video Filter for Your MS Teams Meetings



Join Meeting

Go to your Calendar in Teams and select Join.



Enable Camera

Make sure your camera is on.



Open Effects

Click the Effects and avatars or Video effects button on the pre-join screen.



Select Filter

Choose from Backgrounds, Filters (like styles or frames), or select More video effects to add new ones or blur your background.



Apply

Click **Done** to set it before joining.

Applying a Video Filter for Your Zoom Meetings



Locate the Video Icon

In your Zoom meeting, find the camera icon at the bottom-left of the screen.



Open the Menu

Click the small upward arrow () next to the video icon.



Choose Filter

Select "Choose Video Filter" from the dropdown menu.



Apply Filter

A sidebar will open; click on any filter to apply it to your video feed instantly.



Apply Filter

Click **Done** to set it before joining.
