If you applied to Seneca but have not yet been accepted, we encourage you to review all the steps on this checklist, so you are fully prepared to begin your studies.

Studying From Home

This checklist is for international students who (i) have applied for their study permit before Aug. 31, 2022, (ii) will be staying in their home country, and (iii) joining classes online because they cannot travel due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Students are encouraged to travel as soon as it is safe to do so. (NOTE: If you will be moving to Canada to take your classes here, please refer to the **TRAVELLING TO CANADA** version of this document.)



IMPORTANT INFORMATION >

If you're already studying online from outside Canada, you must have submitted your study permit application no later than Aug. 31, 2022 to continue studying abroad.

If you are a new student in the Fall (Sept.) 2022 Term, you must submit a study permit application prior to beginning your program.



Your Application/Acceptance Checklist

IMPORTANT TO-DO'S



To complete as soon as possible

If your application is accepted, you will receive an email requesting confirmation of your program choice on Student Home.
When you have confirmed your program, you will receive an official Letter of Acceptance (LOA).
SAVE your LOA — it is filled with important dates and information.
To secure a place in your program, you must pay your first semester fees by the due date noted in the fee statement.
Act fast, some programs fill early.
Once you have your LOA for the Fall (Sept.) 2022 Term, you should immediately apply online for a Student Visa (Study Permit) before Aug. 31, 2022. If your program includes a co-op or work placement, you should apply for the Student Visa (Study Permit) and Co-op Work Permit together right away.
Some programs require you to take an online SKILLS ASSESSMENT TEST . Book your test and find more information online.

NOTE: Seneca's online skills assessment appointments fill quickly. If you have not already completed the skills assessment, please book an assessment online by selecting Newnham Campus. You cannot complete your class schedule until you have completed a skills assessment.

Beginning Apr. 13, you can select a class schedule. When studying from your home country, you must select onlin delivery for all your classes. Instructions can be found online.
