INTRODUCTION

This document describes the steps for students to access the new WHMIS Certificate - [WHMIS Certification Training | Free eCourse](#).

PROCEDURE

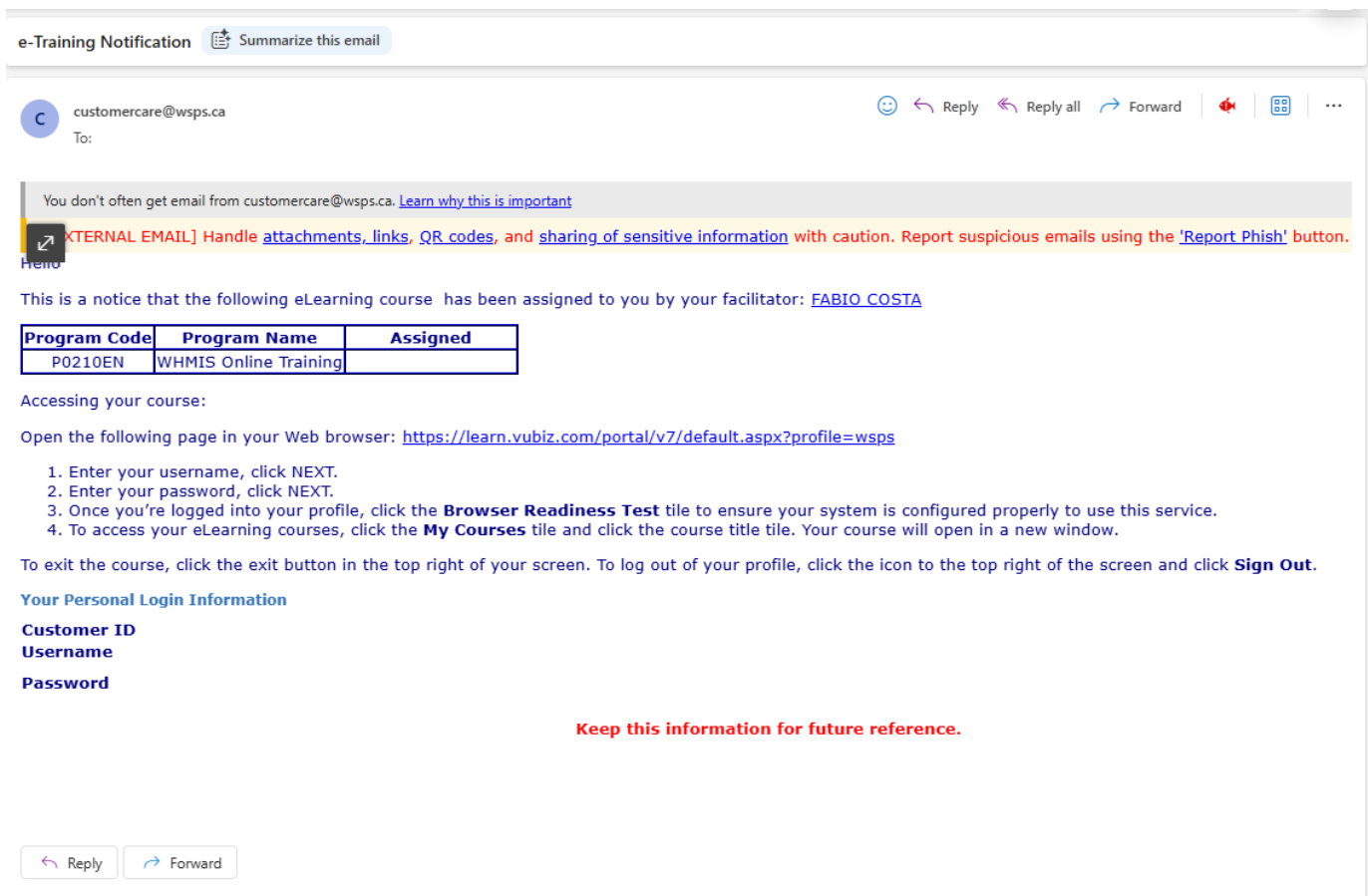


Figure 1: Email from WSPS.

- You will receive an email from customercare@wsps.ca (Figure 1).
- Log in to the **WSPS eCourse** webpage to ensure you have access to the tool. If you have not received an email by the end of Week 1, contact your instructor.
- You are welcome to review the instruction modules on your own, but the final test must be done **in person during the Lab 2 class**.

COURSE MODULES

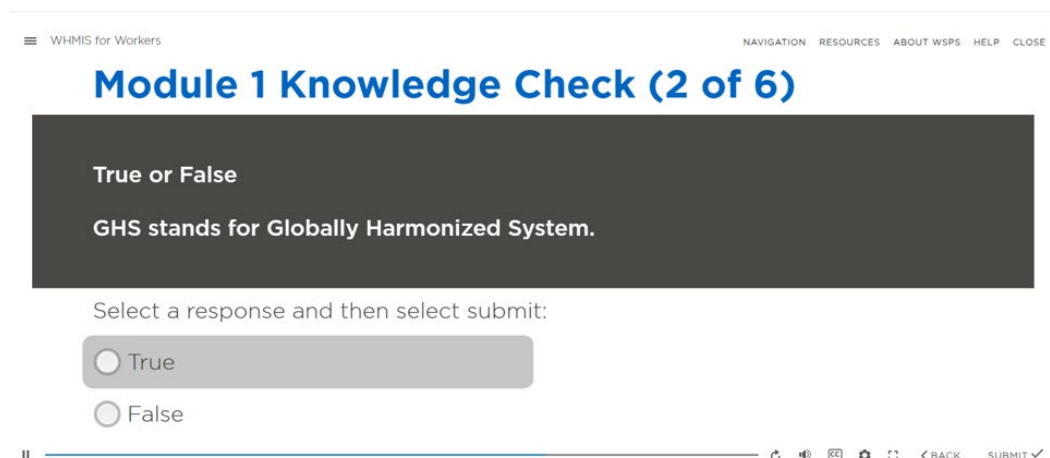


Figure 4: Knowledge check questions.

The training has seven modules. Each module includes videos (**Figure 2**), reading sections (**Figure 3**) and knowledge check questions (**Figure 4**). These questions are not part of the final test. The training modules take about two hours to complete, and we strongly recommend reviewing them before class.

Training Module: 2 hours total:

- Module 1: About WHMIS (15 mins)
- Module 2: About Chemical Hazards (30 mins)
- Module 3: Hazard Classes and Pictograms (30 mins)
- Module 4: Labels (20 mins)
- Module 5: Safety Data Sheets (SDS) (15 mins)
- Module 6: Controlling Chemical Hazards (10 mins)
- Module 7: Legal Rights and Duties (10 mins)

WHMIS focuses on four aspects of working with hazardous materials:

- Safe use
- Safe handling
- Proper storage
- Proper disposal procedures

WHMIS is intended to help protect you from hazards through labels, safety data sheets, and worker training.

2. Upload it to the Lab 2 Blackboard Dropbox.

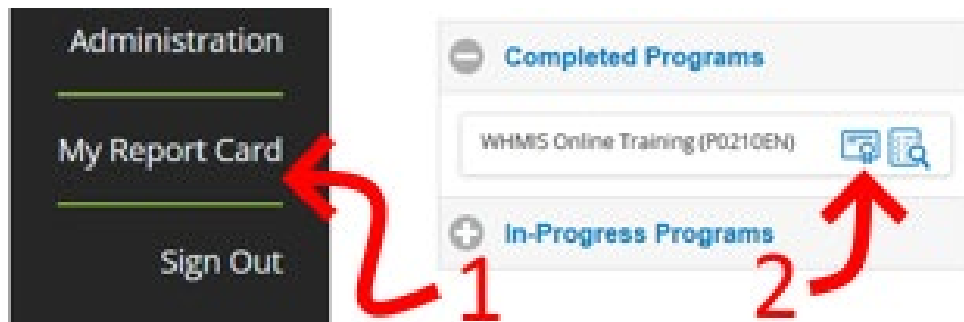


Figure 5: Instructions to download the certificate.
