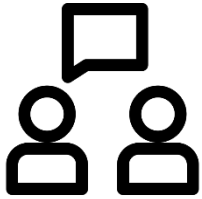


Dropping Courses with DNC Grading

'DNC' stands for 'did not complete.' Courses dropped now will receive a grade of DNC which does appear on your transcript, but it does not affect your GPA. Learn more about Seneca's [Grading Policy](#).
