- **Enrolment Verification Letter and an Official Transcript issued by Seneca**
 - Request your letter by completing an [Enrolment Verification Request form](#) online
 - Request your [official transcript](#) online
- **Copy of your study permit**
- **Proof of means of financial support**
 - Acceptable documents include bank statements, proof of education loans, proof of tuition payment(s) or pay stubs from your part-time employer
 - All documents should be merged in a single PDF file
- **Copy of Passport**
 - Scan the page with your photo and all pages with stamps and visas
 - All documents should be merged in a single PDF file
- **Digital Photo**
- **Proof of medical exam (if applicable):**
 - A medical exam may be required depending on your country of residence for the past 12 months and your program of study. Your medical exam results are valid for 12 months.

You need to complete the form and validate it before uploading. For further instructions on completing a standard study permit extension application, view the [resources available online from IRCC](#).

Submitting Your Passport to the IRCC

After submitting an online application, you must wait for an email from IRCC requesting your original passport to be mailed. To submit your passport, IRCC recommends that you purchase from Canada Post:

1. One prepaid letter-sized (318 x 241mm) Regional Canada Post Xpresspost envelope, AND
2. One pre-paid standard-sized (260 x 159mm) Post Xpresspost envelope

You will use the first envelope to send your passport to IRCC and IRCC will use the second envelope to mail back your passport to you after affixing your Temporary Resident Visa (TRV).
