

# SEMET Laboratory Code of Behaviour

To ensure the safety of all students and faculty within SEMET Labs at the Newnham campus, the following rules apply in the following labs:

- 1) Students are always expected to conduct themselves professionally and safely. Be aware of the nearest fire extinguisher, the location of the safety station and its supplies in the SEMET Lab.
- 2) Food or drink is not allowed at any time.
- 3) Safety glasses are mandatory when the power is ON.
- 4) Other precautionary safety equipment will be used or worn when necessary.
- 5) Open-toed shoes or sandals are not allowed in the lab.
- 6) Long hair must be tied back.
- 7) All laboratory equipment brought into SEMET labs must be CSA-approved and in good working order.
- 8) Vandalism of any kind will not be tolerated; please note that security cameras are in place to protect the polytechnic's property and occupant safety. Offenders will be subject to the terms of the Seneca's Student Rights and Responsibilities Policy.
