Seneca Polytechnic and Amity University Dubai have **signed a memorandum of understanding** (MOU) to facilitate a variety of cross-institutional opportunities.

The MOU commits the two organizations to exploring the potential for students and faculty exchanges, developing applied research capabilities and examining microcredential and pathway opportunities.

President David Agnew and Dr. Saif Al Seiri, Vice Chancellor, Amity University Dubai, signed the memorandum on Monday, June 12 at Amity's Dubai campus in the United Arab Emirates (UAE).

Witnessing the signing were Lindsay Margenau, Chargé d'affaires at the *Consulate General of Canada* in Dubai, and Dr. Fazal Malik, Pro Vice Chancellor, Amity University Dubai.

The partnership between Seneca and Amity aligns with UAE's National Strategy for Higher Education 2030 to facilitate international student and staff mobility.
