Obtaining an AutoCAD license

To get your AutoCAD license:

- 1. Go to Autodesk to create an account using your Seneca email address
- 2. After the account is created, go to AutoCAD
- 3. Log in (if prompted) and complete your profile with your student information
- 4. Autodesk will ask for verification document (transcript, student card, etc.)
- 5. Upload the document and once validated Autodesk will send a verification email
- 6. Log in to AutoCAD
- 7. Choose the product operating system, version and language
- 8. Click Install Now
- 9. Once installed the license key will be sent to your Seneca email address
- 10. Activate the software at first launch
