Students and faculty within the **School of Environmental and Civil Engineering Technology** can download ArcGIS for desktop at no cost.

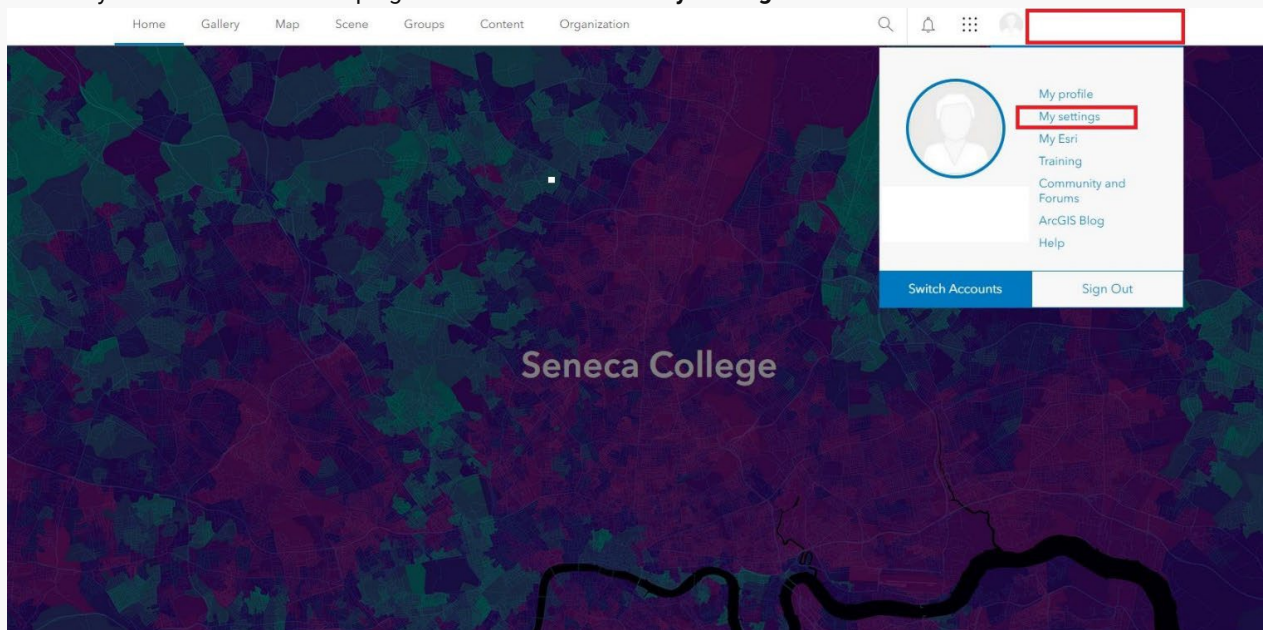
If you are enrolled in an eligible program, or are employed through one of the eligible schools, you can obtain a single-user license and the software to install ArcGIS on your home computer.
