Preventing theft from lockers is a priority for everyone. By reducing the opportunity for individuals to access your locker and the value of objects in it, you can help reduce the risk of locker theft.



Consider using some of these prevention strategies to keep yourself safe on campus:

- Secure and lock your items while using any locker on campus
- Never leave your valuables unattended and keep them out of sight
- Check that your locker is shut and locked before walking away
- Ensure that you are using a sturdy and reliable lock

- Keep your locker combination confidential
- Not leaving valuables in your locker overnight or on weekends
- Report all incidents and suspicious activity to Security or the police


- If you suspect you have been a victim of theft, remain calm and try to retrace your steps first. You may ask around if anyone witnessed someone moving your items. Your friends might be helping you!
- Photograph any evidence of damage to or near your locker and provide these photos to security
- You can also check the **Lost & Found** at any security office on campus or file a report with security.
- You can report your issue online to your local police non-emergency public reporting website.
