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When logged into Copilot using your Seneca ID, your prompts and responses remain private  and are not accessible to Microsoft or used for AI training. Look for the 'Protected' badge - it indicates that you are in Protected Mode. This feature allows you to chat with Copilot in a safer and more private secure environment. Here's what it means:

1. **Privacy Assurance:** When Protected Mode is enabled, your chats and data are not stored or shared with anyone, including Microsoft. **Copilot won't remember your previous chats, and it won't use them to improve responses.**
2. **No Data Retention:** Your conversations remain confidential, and Copilot won't retain any information from your chats. This ensures that your privacy is respected.
3. **Safer Interaction:** The green badge signifies that you're interacting with Copilot in a secure environment. No personal data is collected or analyzed during your session.
