How it works

Get your ticket(s)

On August 7 from noon to 2 p.m., and on August 8 from 11 a.m. to noon, drop off your gently used clothes and accessories to SSF's office. For each item you donate, you will receive a ticket. Then, from noon to 2:30 p.m. on August 8, join us at the Kickback to exchange your tickets for new-to-you items from the swap collection.

In addition, Baro Vintage, a student-owned company, will offer a selection of its pre-loved items for sale as part of the event.
