The School of English and Liberal Studies is excited to announce a new experiential learning opportunity for students.

Our first **SEAT** course runs this fall, and **we need your help to spread the word** to students in your diploma programs.

SEAT stands for **SELS Experiential Academic Travel**.

Highlights:

- Students can earn one General Education Elective Credit in the Sciences and Social Sciences Category.
- Delivery Mode: Hybrid. The course includes an in-person orientation session, followed by five weeks of asynchronous online learning and concluding with a three day, two night stay on the grounds of Haliburton Forest and Wild Life Reserve in Haliburton, Ontario.
- Course concludes on Friday, October 25, 2024
- Fee of \$462.50 in addition to regular tuition fees covers roundtrip transportation to [Haliburton Forest & Wild Life Reserve](#) from Newnham Campus, accommodations, meals, and admittance to tours and Wolf Centre.

Please note: This opportunity is open to students who have completed one semester at Seneca and are enrolled in a full-time program with a Sciences/Social Sciences General Education requirement.
