## Microsoft changing OneDrive storage limits for students on Dec. 20

Starting on Friday, Dec 20, OneDrive accounts for Seneca Polytechnic students will be limited to 1 GB per account. This is due to changes Microsoft is making to its Microsoft 365 for Education suite.

Any account that exceeds this limit will become read-only. While existing stored files can still be accessed, no new files can be uploaded until space has been freed up.

With the move to the cloud, the number of stored files and the amount of data most of us use has increased significantly over time. Given the new limit, it's important for us all to monitor and manage our OneDrive usage.
