## Important dates to remember

Participation in the eTextbook initiative is optional for students in most full-time programs and courses. If you are enrolled in a program or course that uses eTextbooks for the Fall 2025 Term, please note the following important dates:

- The "Textbooks and Materials" fee will appear in your [Student Home](#) account between Thursday, Aug. 14 and Monday, Sept. 15. This fee will replace the cost of purchasing physical textbooks for your course(s)
- If opting out of the eTextbook program is an option for you, then you received an email from Follett bookstore on Sunday, Aug. 24 with instructions on how to opt out
- Your deadline to opt out is **Monday, Sept. 15, 2025**
