Students are equipped with knowledge, provided mentorship and given access to microgrant opportunities.

Skills developed in the EWIL program will be valuable whether the student wants to start their own business or join an existing one.



Upon successful completion of the 13-week EWIL, students will receive:

- their academic WIL credit
- a HELIX micro-badge
- acceptance into HELIX to continue to develop their new venture

Launched in September 2024, the EWIL is available to both international and domestic

students in selected programs.
