If you've completed your program requirements but don't want to be considered for graduation because you would like to re-take/upgrade a specific course grade, you can opt out of graduation by doing the following:

1. Log into Student Home
2. Select the Academic Records tab to access "View Graduation Status"
3. At the bottom of the page, select the option to opt out of graduating

The last day to opt out of graduation is the last day of the term. If you opted out of graduation by accident or changed your mind about wanting to attend, send an email to theservicehub@senecapolytechnic.ca.
