Important dates to remember

- The fee associated with the eTextbooks will appear in your [Student Home](#) account by Wednesday, Jan. 29. This fee will replace the cost of purchasing physical textbooks for your course(s)
- You can choose to opt out of the initiative, you should have received an email from Follett bookstore on Sunday, Dec. 29, 2024 with instructions on how to opt out
- Your deadline to opt out is **Thursday, Jan. 30**
