Ontario-Ukraine Solidarity Scholarship

Value: \$10,000

Deadline: February 15, 2026

In response to the Russian military invasion of Ukraine, on April 6, 2022, the provincial government announced the creation of a \$1.9 million Ontario-Ukraine Solidarity Scholarship to support students attending Ontario's publicly assisted colleges and universities. The purpose of these funds is to provide support to students directly or indirectly impacted by the Ukrainian conflict or students impacted by other conflicts.

Eligibility Criteria:

- You must be enrolled full-time at Seneca Polytechnic for the current 2025-2026 academic year of study. International and domestic applicants could be eligible. However, applicants must have a valid temporary or permanent Social Insurance Number on file in their Student Home account.
- You must complete the financial needs eligibility requirement and demonstrate financial need.
- You must have a minimum GPA of 3.5. An admission average equivalent to at least a 3.5 GPA will be required for students who started their studies at Seneca Polytechnic but have not yet obtained final grades for a full term of study. The GPA or admission average on file with the institution will be used for this determination.
- You would need to include your community involvement. This could include volunteering, participation in organized clubs, training courses and other activities, or informal activities in the community.
