Social Insurance Clinics

To <u>legally work in Canada</u>, you need a nine-digit <u>Social Insurance Number</u> (SIN) issued by Service Canada.

At the beginning of each term, Seneca Polytechnic invites Service Canada to come to each campus to issue a SIN on the spot.

Bring original and valid documents listed below to your appointment:

- A study permit issued by IRCC or CIC which indicates the permit holder "may accept employment or "may work" in Canada.
- A passport.

Note: Digital documents are not accepted. Visit the Government of Canada website to view a list of acceptable documents.

To guarantee an appointment time, International Students must **register** for a specific time slot:

- Wednesday, May 28, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. Room D2014, Newnham Campus
- Thursday, May 29, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. Room S1209, Seneca@York Campus
