- Monday, April 14: 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.
- Tuesday, April 15: 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.
- Wednesday, April 16: 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.

To vote, you must be at least 18 years old and a Canadian citizen. Remember to bring your ID. When you vote on campus, you'll be casting a special ballot for a candidate in the riding where your place of ordinary residence is located. This convenient option allows you to fulfill your civic duty without leaving campus.
