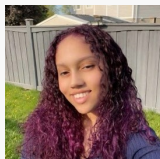
General Education

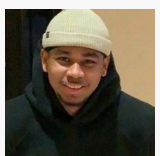

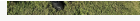
Law, Administration & Public Safety
