

School of Fashion professor outfits JUNO Awards host

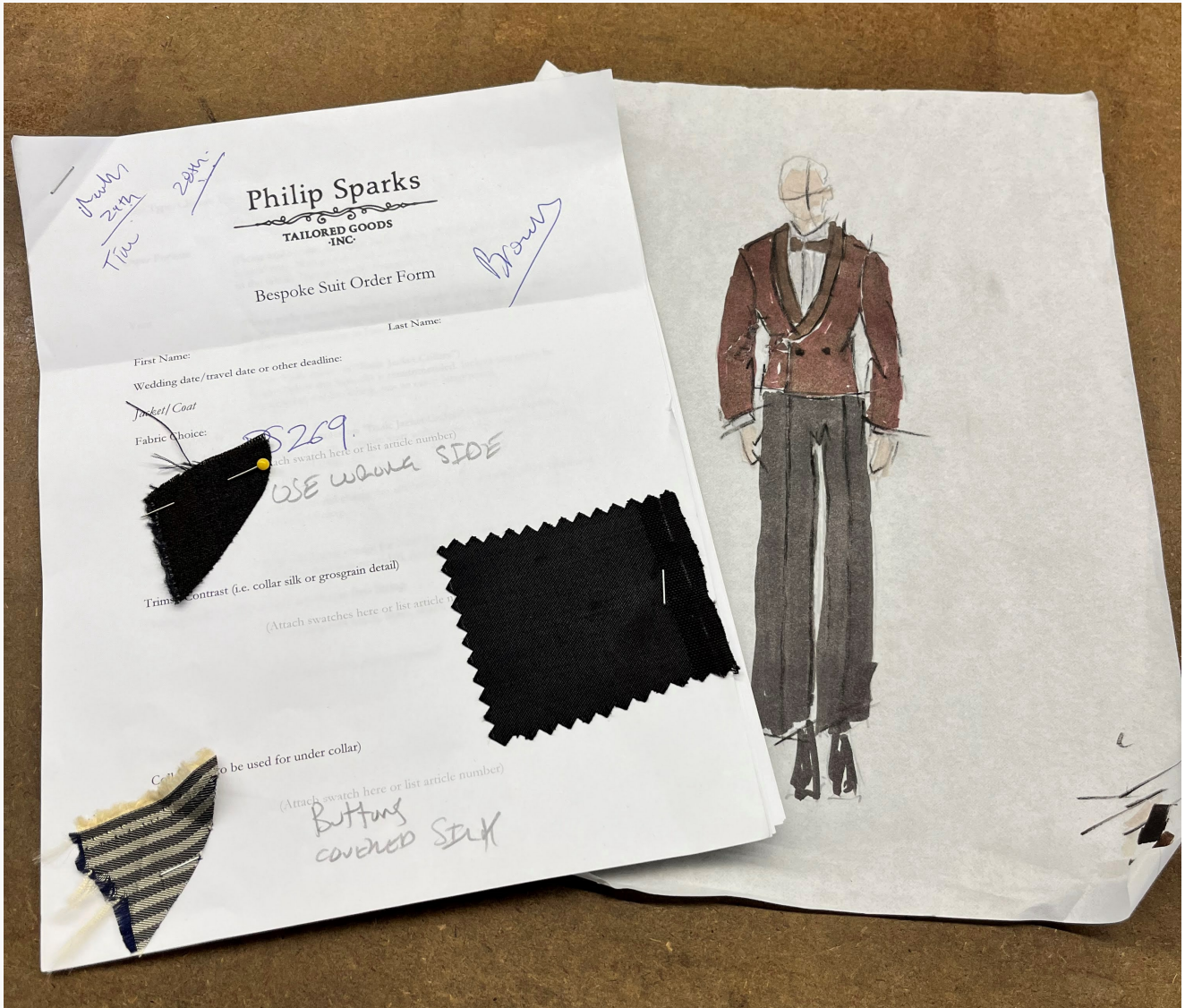
