## Step 1: Find a Global Learning Opportunity

## Step 4: Meet with your Academic Program Area

Your Academic Program Area is a huge support as you plan your Global Learning Opportunity. Talk to them about: (1) where you are in your Seneca program, (2) how the Global Learning Opportunity fits with your academic program and (3) completing and signing your learning agreement

A signed Outbound Student Learning Agreement is required for your application. Both you and the Academic Program Area (Student Advisor, Program Co-ordinator, or Academic Program Manager) must sign the document.

Step 5: Apply

No matter the Global Learning Opportunity, we have ONE application.

Start your Outbound Student Mobility Application via MoveON (Sign in with your Seneca credentials)

Complete applications include two major items: (1) Signed Learning Agreement and a (2) Personal Statement. Additional instructions/details are in the online application.
