Anyone who has been affected by sexual violence has the right to:

- be believed
- be treated with dignity and respect
- be informed about on- and off-campus services and resources
- decide whether or not to access available services and to choose those services they feel will be most beneficial
- decide whether to report to Security Services and/or local police
- have an investigation conducted with the institution's full cooperation
- have a safety plan
- have reasonable and necessary actions taken to prevent further unwanted contact

with the alleged perpetrator(s)
