Seneca College's Building Environmental Systems (BES) programs adhere to the fundamental premise that the building is a holistic system in which heating, air conditioning, refrigeration, ventilation, electrical power, lighting, water and air supply are connected and interdependent. They focus on the knowledge required to understand the functioning of all systems in commercial, institutional and residential buildings with a strong emphasis on sustainability and energy efficiency. The programs also cover how buildings can be operated and maintained more efficiently.
