## How to apply

If you are a new user:

- 1. Register for an account.
- 2. Complete and submit the application online.
- 3. Print, sign and upload the requested documents. For example, consents, declarations and signature pages.
- 4. Follow the instructions indicated to complete the Master Student Financial Assistance Agreement (MSFAA).

If you are a returning user:

- 1. Log into your OSAP account using your OAN and account password.
- 2. Complete and submit the application online.

If requested, upload any required documents and follow the MSFAA instructions indicated.

## Additional supporting documentation

The Ministry of Colleges and Universities may request you to provide additional supporting documentation, including but not limited to:

- Record of Landing
- Permanent Resident Card
- Proof of Income
- Marriage Certificate

- Separation Agreement
- Divorce Certificate
- Federal Government Child Tax Benefit
- Birth Certificates of Children
- An affidavit detailing the custody arrangement of your child(ren)
- Proof of Residence History
- Academic transcript
