Seneca uses the [Ontario Colleges Math Test \(OCMT\)](#) to determine your knowledge in math as you prepare to enrol in college-level courses.

The assessment covers the following math topic areas: whole numbers, arithmetic, integers, decimals, fractions, ratios and proportions, percents, basic algebra, and measurements. Calculators are **not permitted** for this assessment.
