Only the **Aviation Operations (AVO)** and **Aviation Safety (ASE)** programs require a FASET math Skills Assessment. If you have [booked your Skills Assessment](#) at the Test Centre, it is recommended that you prepare for your FASET Math Skills Assessment. This will ensure that your math skills are accurately evaluated and that you are placed in the appropriate math course during your first semester of study.

Seneca uses the [Ontario Colleges Math Test \(OCMT\)](#) designed for FASET students to determine your knowledge in math as you prepare to enrol in college-level courses.

The assessment covers the following math topic areas: arithmetic, percents, ratios and proportions, basic algebra, linear correlation, graphs and systems of linear equations and measurements. Use of a hand-held calculator is permitted for this assessment.
