## The following awards are now open for application

### Tuition Assistance Bursary

**Award Code:** 100008

**Value:** Dependent on Financial Need

**Deadline:** June 15, 2024

To Assist Domestic students with the cost of tuition. Student must be Domestic Students and demonstrate Financial need. Look up Award Code.

If you have already applied for the 2023-2024 academic year you cannot apply again.

### Diploma-to-Degree Scholarship

Open to students starting in the Fall, Winter or Summer semesters

For the Fall term the application opens July 15

For the Winter term the application opens Dec. 1

For the Summer term the application opens May 1

**Deadline:** 10th day of classes

Award Description: A one-time scholarship of \$2,500 to qualified postsecondary diploma graduates who are pursuing a Seneca degree and have not received a renewable entrance scholarship.

To be eligible for this award you must also:

- have an incoming GPA 75% or 3.3 GPA and above
- complete the online Financial Aid Application through Student Home by selecting the “Financial Aid” tile, then “Apply for Financial Aid”
- be enrolled full time

## Renewable Degree Scholarships

Open to students starting in the Fall, Winter or Summer semesters

**Deadline:** 10th day of classes

Full-time students starting in any of Seneca’s full-time degree programs can qualify for a renewable scholarship based on their Grade 12 grades or grades from another postsecondary program. Total four-year scholarship for one credential based on maintenance of grades:

70% or 3.0 GPA+ — \$2,000 (\$500 per year)

75% or 3.3 GPA+ — \$3,000 (\$750 per year)

80% or 3.6 GPA+ — \$4,000 (\$1,000 per year)

The renewable scholarship is based on grades in continuing years of the student's program of study and the student maintaining full-time status.

## Frank H. Hori Charitable Foundation Award

**Award Code:** 200249

**Value:** \$1000

**Deadline:** June 15, 2024

Awarded to full-time domestic Personal Support Worker students who demonstrate financial need and have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5. Recipients will be selected by the Seneca Awards Committee.

## 200363 Leonard and Gabryela Osin Foundation PSW Award

**Award Code:** 200363

**Value:** \$2500

**Deadline:** June 15, 2024

Awarded to a full-time domestic student in the non-accelerated Personal Support Worker program studying at Seneca's King campus. The student must have demonstrated financial need and academic achievement (min GPA of 3.5).

## FCE Student Levy Bursary

**Award Code:** 100487

**Value:** \$250

**Deadline:** June 15, 2024

Bursaries to assist students registered in any diploma/certificate program with the Faculty of Continuing Education and Training.

## Indigenous Student Bursary

**Award Code:** 200043

**Deadline:** June 15

**Value:** \$1000

The Indigenous Student Bursary is an award provided to self-identified Indigenous students with financial need who are attending postsecondary programs and/or training programs at either Ontario publicly-assisted colleges and universities, or any of the nine Indigenous Institutes in Ontario

### Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for the Indigenous Student Bursary, a student must self-identify as an Indigenous person in Canada. For the purposes of this bursary, an Indigenous person in Canada is anyone who states that they are an Indigenous person, that is, First Nations, Métis or Inuk (Inuit).

The bursary is available to students for any year of the program they are enrolled in. Students who have previous postsecondary education are still eligible to receive the Indigenous Student Bursary.

To be eligible for this bursary, students must:

- self-identify as an Indigenous person in Canada;

- demonstrate financial need (as identified by the financial aid office for students attending publicly-assisted colleges or universities, the Indigenous Education Council for
- students attending Indigenous Institutes, or through their OSAP application);
- be attending an approved institution; and
- meet the Canadian citizenship and Ontario residency requirements as outlined below.
