

# How do I drop a course?

To drop a class without it appearing on your transcript and with a refund (where eligible), you must drop it [through Student Home](#) by the [Last Day](#) to drop course(s) without receiving a grade and with a refund (this is generally the 10th day of classes in an academic session).

After this deadline, you are still eligible to drop a class through [Student Home](#) without a refund by clicking the **Manage Classes** tile and selecting **Drop Classes**. Select **Yes** on the courses you'd like to drop and click **Submit**. You must submit your request before the [last day](#) to drop courses and receive a DNC (did not complete) grade. A DNC grade appears on your transcript but has no impact on your grade point average. [Learn more](#) about DNC grades.

You cannot drop a course after the DNC deadline.

If you are thinking about dropping a course at any point, it is recommended to first talk with your student adviser to see if there are alternate options and to make sure you understand the implications of dropping the course for your academic progress.

Please note that dropping courses can have implications for your study status (full vs. part time) and/or your OSAP eligibility.
