Liberal Studies Courses

Liberal Studies courses are breadth courses and complement professional courses in **degree programs**. Liberal Studies requirements contribute to students' knowledge of society and culture, skills relevant to civic engagement, and strengthen critical thinking, quantitative reasoning, and written and oral communication skills.

Liberal Studies Requirements

Liberal Studies courses at Seneca are classified as either lower- or upper-level and falls into one of the following three categories: *Humanities, Social Sciences or Sciences*.

Students in **degree programs** must meet the following Liberal Studies Requirements:

- successful completion of Liberal Studies courses in at least two (2) of the three (3) categories (Humanities, Sciences and Social Sciences)
- successful completion in at least two (2) upper-level Liberal Studies courses
- successful completion of at least one (1) lower-level, or English or Critical Thinking course is required before enrolling in an upper-level Liberal Studies Course.
