

Start by getting the app

On your phone, install the Microsoft Authenticator app. [Download now.](#)

1. Go to <https://myid.senecapolytechnic.ca/mfasetup>
2. Enter your **Seneca email address** and click Next



After you install the Microsoft Authenticator app on your device, choose "Next".




If prompted, allow notifications. Then add an account, and select "Work or school".


11. Using the Authenticator app to scan the QR code and click Next.
