Once you have activated your Seneca account and you know your password, you can log into myid.senecapolytechnic.ca at any time and change your password. Using a strong password that is at least 8 characters long and that contains uppercase and lowercase letters, numbers, and symbols. We recommend that you change your password often and regularly.

1. Go to MyID – myid.senecapolytechnic.ca
2. Select Change Password
3. Enter your password
4. You will now be prompted to change your password. Your password must meet the [minimum requirements](#) to proceed.
 - a. Enter your password in the “Old Password” field
 - b. Enter your new password and confirm your new password
 - c. Click Submit
